

HISTORICAL FATE OF THE SERBIAN PEOPLE

These are great and responsible times that the Serbs are experiencing. Three decades of bloody robbery and rule of the Serbian comprador bourgeoisie over the Serbian people and oppressed national minorities of Serbia, three decades of trading with Serbia on the market of imperialist bandits (America, Russia, China, France... etc) – all this is taking a bloody revenge on the Serbian people and the oppressed national minorities of Serbia.

The omnipotence of irresponsible cliques, the most varied misery for the ever-widening strata of the working masses, economic disorganization and decay, scarcity and costliness, hunger; All this now characterizes the rule of the Serbian comprador lords. While large landowners allow foreign companies to own countless hectares of land, the Serbian peasant, instead of owning the land he toils, perishes without land, without forests, without pasture.

In foreign policy, the Serbian comprador bourgeoisie has handed the country over to semi-colonial slavery, destroying any potential for the real industrialization of Serbia and the growth of its productive forces. It sowed hatred and the causes of new wars with the neighboring nations of the former Yugoslavia. Against these peoples, who make up the vast majority of the population, the Serbian comprador bourgeoisie pursues a policy of conquest, persecution and denationalization.

In domestic politics, it has usurped all power and established a reactionary liberal regime, to which it gives legitimacy only through farce elections through which it ridicules the will of the people and their right to freely politically affiliate. The so-called "civil opposition" represents only a reserve of the ruling Great-Serb comprador bourgeoisie, which will be given a leading role in the government if it is proven necessary to change the form of bourgeois dictatorship.

All this shows that Serbia, in the midst of the rule of high traitors and comprador lords, is now on its knees. The comprador bourgeoisie justifies its "failure" (it is more accurate to say national treason) with nationalist fantasies; it dreams of returning to the hegemonic position in the Balkans that it had in the Kingdom of Yugoslavia when Croatian and Slovenian bourgeoisie capitulated to the Serbian militaristic monarchy under the pressure of the Entente. That this illusion is so unattainable for them, they justify with the alleged "betrayal" of Serbia by fraternal oppressed peoples, primarily the Albanian people in Kosovo, the Croat, Bosniak and Montenegrin people. Buying and attracting to power individual representatives of the bourgeoisie and landowners of fraternal oppressed peoples does not in any way diminish the Great-Serb character of this policy.

The Serbian people today are enslaved under the dictatorship of that scum of various degenerates who sold the land to the imperialists at the first opportunity and grabbed the lion's share of the plunder over the people. Under these conditions, whoever can lead the people in driving imperialism out of the country and establishing democratic power will be the savior of the Serbs. History has proven that today only one class is capable of such an undertaking – the proletariat. It is called upon to organize itself as a class into its own political party – the Communist Party – and to organize around itself all the revolutionary classes that want to see the collapse of comprador rule and the establishment of a new, true democracy, regardless of the prejudices and illusions from which they still suffer.

Communists must renounce all lies that, supposedly, the development in Serbia leads to a quick and inevitable catastrophe of the regime and that a spontaneous uprising of the masses will solve the democratic question. The democratic question today is not solvable except as part of the World Proletarian Revolution, without the prospect of a classless socialist society, it is not possible to

overthrow imperialism and its lackeys and establish a democratic republic. A democratic republic today can only be established by a proletariat striving for a classless society.

Therefore, the primary task of the conscious socialist proletariat of Serbia is to fight for the reconstitution of its progressive and organized detachment – the Communist Party.

And since the Croatian, Bosnian, Slovenian, Montenegrin and Macedonian peoples are today just as enslaved as the Serbian people, the struggle of the Serbian people will not and cannot remain only their struggle. It must necessarily be united with the struggles of these fraternal peoples. That is why we communists in formation from all parts of former Yugoslavia have united in the Committee for the Reconstitution of the Communist Party of Yugoslavia. Our peoples have suffered the same fate, and the solution to their problems is the same.

The questions before us, the Communists in formation, are whether we will be capable enough to overcome the dispersion of forces, to unite on a programmatic basis and to fight against the common enemy of all our peoples. History will answer this question decisively.

The same fate awaits the Serb as his oppressed brothers – the most terrible battles are yet to come, but their fruit will be new democracy, fraternal peace among nations, socialism!
