

At the age of 76, comrade Nada Ilić suddenly passed away.

Comrade Nada never pushed herself into the spotlight, but she was well known to communist militants as a tireless fighter. In her final years, comrade Nada contributed significantly to the Committee for the Reconstitution of the Communist Party of Yugoslavia, contributing not only financially and with the food of her humble bowls, but also using the skills and immense experience that she had.

It is wholly understandable that it was difficult for comrade Nada Ilić to understand many of the issues of the revolutionary movement, yet, despite this, she understood the fundamental question in Maoism – the question of power. Our comrades remember well the many conversations they had with her. Thus, comrade Nada contributed not only materially, but also in the ideological development of militants.

Every Maoist militant must be grateful for the great contribution of comrade Nada Ilić. Our deepest condolences go out to her family and loved ones.
